Tech Notes:

Q: Where do I put the line filters that came with my DSL modem?

The line filters are designed to keep voice traffic from interfering with DSL traffic on your phone system. The line filters must be used on every phone jack in the house that has a phone or fax machine connected to it. This includes security systems, monitoring systems, etc. The line filter should not go on your DSL line.
